





As part of Sanad's vision to develop the Iraqi economy through entrepreneurship, we were delighted to collaborate with the United Nations Institute for Training and Research (UNITAR) as part of their program titled (UNITAR COVID-19 Response and Recovery Programme: Mobilizing Resilient Entrepreneurs to Address Food Insecurity, Public Health and Unemployment - For Youth in Iraq) which equips youth entrepreneurs in Iraq with the knowledge, skills, and attitudes to turn ideas for a social or for-profit enterprise into a business model that meets the urgent domestic needs stemming from the COVID-19 pandemic and that promotes sustainable recovery.

Sanad's offered its expertise and presented a session on Food Security and Agribusiness – Iraq by Sanad's CEO Dr. Sameh W. Al-Muqdadi in which he offered an overview about the current situation with focus on the challenges related to water resources management and opportunities of agribusiness in the current Iraqi landscape, the session was attended by the Iraqi learners of the program as well as UNITAR staff from Iraq and Japan, the attendance showed interest in the topic and the session concluded after engaging discussions with the presenter especially exploring the future opportunities that the future entrepreneur can utilize to support the Iraqi economy.

Theprogram aims to empower entrepreneurship training program for aspiring and established entrepreneurs, leaders, and members of micro, small, and medium enterprises (MSMEs) in Egypt, Iraq, and Lebanon, provide them with the knowledge, skills, and network they need to turn their ideas for a social or for-profit enterprise into a business model that addresses challenges from the COVID-19 pandemic and contributes to building a resilient health sector in the region. The program consists of three phases:

PHASE 1: Introduces you to the fundamentals of entrepreneurship, innovation, and public health

PHASE 2: Will focus on building your leadership skills to drive innovation and enterprise development. The first two phases will take place entirely online. After a competitive selection process, outstanding participants will progress to the final phase.

PHASE 3: Selected participants in mentoring sessions and a face-to-face workshop that will drive their business forward.

Sanad Organization for Economic Development participated in Berlin climate change and security conference (#BCSC2022) which was entitled Climate – Conflict – Clash of Crises: Weathering the Risks. BCSC 2022 convened high-level political actors, climate security experts, and practitioners at the German Federal Foreign Office in Berlin on 11-12 October 2022. The Conference addressed climate impacts on peace and stability and its interlinkages with current geopolitical challenges and announcedthe Climate for Peace Initiative (#Climate4Peace) where the participating countries committed to enhancing projects on the ground – such as the Global Shield, Powering Peace through Climate Action, solar energy in refugee camps in the Sahel or Weathering Risk and its Peace Pillar.

Sanad Organization for Economic Development participated in the global workshop which has been organized under the auspices of the Water Convention serviced by UNECE, under the leadership of the Netherlands and Switzerland, in cooperation with the Adaptation Fund, the Food and Agriculture Organisation of the United Nations (FAO), the International Network of Basin Organisations (INBO) and the International Water Management Institute (IWMI).

The workshop brought together more than 200 experts from the water, climate change, agriculture, environment communities as well as from transboundary basin organizations to strengthen cooperation and jointly discuss best practices and lessons learned in addressing water scarcity and water quality through improving climate adaptation and equitable and sustainable water allocation on the national and transboundary levels. Participants included representatives of governments, non-governmental and intergovernmental organizations, international financial institutions, academia, the private sector and other experts.

The special session was during the Global Workshop on Water, Agriculture and Climate Change co-organized by Water Convention/ Protocol on Water & Health, FAO, Adaptation Fund, Federal Office for the Environment FOEN and Ministerie van Infrastructure en Waterstaat International Water Management Institute and International Water Management Institute (IWMI) was held in Geneva, Switzerland on 17 and 18 October.

The United Nations Climate Change Conference, more commonly referred to as COP27 (Conference of the Parties of the UNFCCC), will be the 27th United Nations Climate Change conference, to be held from 6 to 18 November 2022 in Sharm El Sheikh, Egypt. It will take place under the presidency of Egyptian Minister of Foreign Affairs Sameh Shoukry, with more than 90 heads of state and representatives of 190 countries expected to attend.

Sanad organization for economic development participated in the milestone anniversaries of the 20+ years of activities implemented by the APFM, underlining its impacts in promoting the concept of Integrated Flood Management to WMO Members and presenting the way forward in the expansion of its HelpDesk. The event was an opportunity to identify current flood management issues in WMO Members and how APFM programme and Support Base Partners could potentially support the National Hydrological and Meteorological Services in timely managing the flood events.

The Associated Programme on Flood Management (APFM) is a joint initiative of the World Meteorological Organization (WMO) and the Global Water Partnership (GWP). It promotes the concept of Integrated Flood Management (IFM) as a new approach to flood management. The programme is financially supported by the governments of Japan and the Netherlands.

The team of Sanad organization for economic development had a meeting with the WMO senior team to discuss the potential projects in Iraq in terms of Climate change prevention strategies and flood/draught management.

Sanad Organization was leading the Microfinance panel during the event; The CEO of SANAD Dr.Sameh Al-Muqdadi was talked about the Iraqi microfinance sector that holds great promise for private sector growth. Often funding enterprises with small sums of capital, microfinance institutions are critical to ensuring that entrepreneurs and other micro-businesses have early-stage growth capital. The microfinance sector can contribute to economic resilience and growth through the expansion of capital and finance access for entrepreneurs, micro and small enterprises.

Two Microfinance experts have been invited to this panel Mr. Ahmed Alsuraifi the Chairman of Iraqi Microfinance Network and Dr. Abbas Alsaidi the Managing Director of Al-Thiqa Microfinance Organization. The panelists will draw out lessons learned from collective decades of experience working in the sector, with a focus on how to further develop and strengthen the impact of the microfinance sector in Iraq.

Sanad leading and moderating the first session about "Agriculture, Climate, and Investment" The conference brought together a selection of financial institutions, business leaders, and investors along side the Government of Iraqand U.S. government officials to exchange candid views regarding challenges in unlocking finance and increasing opportunities for Iraqi businesses to secure funding. The US Ambassador, Governor of the Iraqi Central Bank and other key officials addressed the audience. Following the welcoming and keynote speeches, attendees benefited from the insights of experts in six panels, with key take aways from each panel. 310 people attended the event; 28% of attendees were women. The Combined potential total social media reach was 500,000.

Based on our social mission we have launched an internship and capacity building program for young graduates. The program that offers 10 seats started in 2019, in cooperation with Ministry of Higher Education and Relief International Organization and different Iraqi Universities in Sulimaniyah.

The internship and capacity building program includes final assignment that helps to provide fresh potential graduate students or High performance students with proper knowledge and prepare them for the local market on the one hand. On the other hand, it receives and improves new ideas from different economic and personal skills aspects. The duration of the program was 100 hours (based on the standard for Ministry of Higher Education), it's started on 25th July 2021 and finished on 12th Aug 2021, including 80 hours in office and 20 hours online.







ENTREPRENEURSHIP AND PROJECT DEVELOPMENT COURSE

As part form our social mission we have launched an internship and capacity building program for young graduates. The program has been started in 2019 in cooperation with Ministry of Higher Education and Relief International Organization and different Iraqi Universities in Sulimaniyah. Due to the successful cohorts, excellent feedbacks, and the great demand - application traffic. The program seats have been extended up to 13 sets(7 Females and 6 Males)for the year 2022.

The internship and capacity building program includes final assignment that helps to provide fresh potential graduate students or High performance students with proper knowledge and prepare them to the local market from one hand and to improve / receive new ideas to the in different economic and personal skills aspects, the duration is 100 hours (based on the standard for Ministry of Higher Education), it's started from 22th July 2022 and finished on 22th Aug 2022, separate to 80 hours in office and 20 hours online.

Sanad Organization for Economic Development, in collaboration with Insight360, a leading company in the field of data science consulting and decision support systems, has provided an opportunity to build skills and create a career path for a group of young men and women interested in data analysis. This training camp was offered by Edubak, a company specializing in practical training and building technical job skills in the field of data using the latest digital technologies in training, and by experts with international experience in the field.

50 scholarships were awarded to participants from different parts of Iraq and from both genders, those candidates attended the training from September 2022 until Dec 2022, 35 has completed and passed the bootcamp successfully along with the internship at Insight360. A state-of-the-art digital platform was used to deliver the training on blended instructor-led and self-study and practice assignments.

AWN INITIATIVE FOR PARALLEL EDUCATION

LOCATION: Iraq-Baghdad, and Anbar

PARTICIPANT'S LEVEL: Volunteer young teachers

The Office of the High Commissioner for Human Rights in Iraq, for 2022, shows "shocking" statistics: Iraq has ~ 5million orphans, representing about 5% of the total number of orphans in the world. 4.5 million Children whose families are below the poverty line. As for education, Iraqi schools are witnessing a mass dropout of students in the primary stage, at a rate of 360 male and female students per day. As the number of dropouts in 2014 was more than 100,000 students and jumped to 131,649 students at the end of 2018, which means that the country is waiting for thousands of illiterates. The lack of interest in orphan children's sponsors to educate or guide them will end up pushing them to human trafficking.

Awn is an educational initiative started in 2017 and supported by Sanad organization for economic development with the cooperation of other local NGOs that provide free education parallel to the government education for orphaned and children in the poor areas. Three educational centers have been opened, where teachers are young specialist's volunteers. 700 students received every year from orphaned children and children of under-poverty families who receive parallel government education. The initiative is including the registration of 300 student's families providing them with food basket and health treatment support. The program is creating more than 30 job opportunities.
